FSC LAUTOKA MILL CRUSHES HIGHEST WEEKLY CANE TONNAGE IN 9 YEARS ACHIEVING 40,004 TONNES IN A WEEK

FSC's Lautoka Mill achieved a milestone last week crushing a 40,004 tonnes of cane and manufacturing 4,229 tonnes of sugar, in seven days. The last time this milestone was achieved was in 2009, almost a decade ago.

Additionally, the sugar makes is the highest weekly achievement in the past 10 years.



Fiji's largest sugar mill encountered start-up problems in July when the crushing season started, but dedication and perseverance of the mill management and staff saw them quickly recover, settle down and regain their crushing momentum.

FSC Chief Executive Officer Graham Clark thanked the mill management and staff saying "this is a fantastic result for Lautoka. And we look forward to a strong finish. I commend the mill management and staff and our industry stakeholders in particular our growers, and lorry operators and drivers, for their continued commitment and perseverance, which is the back-drop of this wonderful result".
