Heavy Diesel Technician/Mechanic

The above position will be responsible for the maintenance and repairs of diesel-powered machinery such as tractors, trucks, locomotives, etc., and, at the same time, take proactive measures to ensure breakdowns are avoided.

Principal Accountabilities:

- Carry out maintenance programmes or attend to machinery breakdowns in line with standard work procedures;
- Ability to run diagnostic tests on vehicle mechanical faults;
- Ability to service and carry out repair work on vehicles and heavy mobile plants such as loaders, forklifts, tractors, and trucks;
- Ability to overhaul engines, replace engines, and rebuild components;
- Correctly identify and initiate part replacements for expected component failures according to the manufacturer's specifications;
- Ensure full care of the Corporation's equipment and machines at all times;
- Ensure all machinery under the Fleet Section is well maintained and serviced, including Oil and tyre changes;
- Maintain detailed records of serviced vehicles and mechanical part inventories;
- Carry out any other duties within the scope of the position or related duties as assigned by the immediate supervisor(s) or the department Manager from time to time.

Qualifications/ Requirements

- Diploma or trade certificate in Mechanical or Heavy Automotive Engineering;
- Advanced knowledge of a vehicle, its electrical system, and the mechanisms of a diesel engine
- In-depth knowledge of diesel engine components and operational mechanisms with strong diagnostic skills;
- Superior knowledge of maintenance tools and repair equipment;
- At least three (3) years of industrial work experience in a similar environment with sound knowledge about transport operations in the Sugar Milling Industry;
- Able to work flexible hours, doing shift work as required and keeping machines operational at all times when needed;
- A team player and must be able to work with minimum supervision;
- Prioritise and manage a large, varied workload and cope with the fast-paced environment.
