



Vacancy: Fitter Machinists (Rarawai Mill [x1] & Labasa Mill [x3])

The Fiji Sugar Corporation Limited invites applications from suitably qualified, innovative, and self-motivated individuals who meet the requirements of this position. The positions will be based at Rarawai and Labasa Mill. The role carries out the Fitting/Machining duties as expected from a competent Fitter/ Machinist in the area assigned in the mill as requested in line with standard operating procedures.

Principal Accountabilities:

- Effectively and safely carry out dismantling of pumps and turbines according to standard Engineering procedures.
- Safely work on the dust hopper Conveyor, Boiler submerge Conveyor, transfer screw Conveyors and Main Ash Conveyor and overhaul for rectification of any malfunction.
- Overhaul of the fans.
- Work on the pumps and check for faults.
- Work on the Rotary Valves (5 Rotary Valves).
- Effectively carry out bearings – fault diagnosis installation and removal.
- Effectively and safely remove damaged or cracked bearings.
- Perform Fit engineering components into assemblies or sub-assemblies.
- Effectively and safely overhaul the Gearbox.
- Safely Operate drilling machines to specifications.
- Perform safely precision slotting operations, including fetched and tapered keyways, according to engineering standards.
- Perform safety tool and cutter grinding works according to standard operating procedures.
- Machine out spare parts in case of emergencies
- Provide guidance on job training to trainees and ensure adherence to OHS and safe working practices are observed.

Qualifications/ Requirements:

- Minimum or equivalent to form 6 pass with minimum basic mechanical knowledge and be an analytical team player, able to handle work pressure.
- Must have a Trade Certificate in Fitting and Machining.
- Must be able to work with minimum supervision.
- Must have 5 years' experience as a Trade Apprentice in Fitting and Machining in the sugar milling industry.
- Must undergone training in other areas of the factory operations.
- Must have sound knowledge of all aspects of mill operations.
